Planning Application for Non-Material Amendment to Outline Planning Permission Reference 2004/2307/P dated 22 December 2006 for the King's Cross Central development site

Section 96A Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended)

On behalf of the King's Cross Central General Partner Limited ('KCCGPL'), please find enclosed an application for a non-material amendment D2 uses set out in Conditions 35(g) and 44 of the Outline Planning Permission (ref. 2004/2307/P) dated 22 December 2006 for the comprehensive mixed-use development of the former railway lands at King's Cross Centre pursuant to Section 96A of the Town and Country Planning Act (as amended).
