I would like to add a very strong objection from the BCAAC to this application. The new forecourt to Kings Cross is an immense improvement on the previous 'extension' which was blighted by advertisements and general tat. A great deal of effort has gone into the design and construction of the vent towers to make them as subdued and 'polite' as possible so as not to distract from the superb listed building behind them. The proposed illuminated signs would completely reverse all of this and be HIGHLY prominent - a complete distraction from the listed station building to which they should be subservient (as are the vents currently).

Although this is not in the BCAAC area Kings Cross is such an important building and 'gateway' to Bloomsbury that we feel we must object in the strongest possible terms to this application. It is completely unacceptable.
