## DECISION

## Householder Application Refused

Address: 89 Hillway London N6 6AB

Proposal: Erection of single storey rear extension at ground floor, erection of a part single part double storey side extension and installation of metal balustrade for a proposed roof terrace to the flank elevation at first floor level, erection of a side and rear dormer roof extension, installation of a chimney stack, new Velux conservation rooflight to the flank elevation and alterations to front façade.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed two storey side extension, by reason of its height, scale and bulk, would not be a subordinate addition to the existing dwelling and would infill the gap between the host building and neighbouring property causing harm to the character



and appearance of the host building and wider conservation area. The proposal would therefore be contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan 2017 and Policy DH of the Highgate Neighbourhood Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
