Dear Mr Clapham,

I'm writing to you to OBJECT because a new neighbour at 32 Kylemore Road has applied to over-develop their property.

They already started on the loft conversion (approved in June) and they're going to remove most of the rear roof and replace it with a large dormer window - making it bigger & different from every other house along this terrace and they also applied for these two planning permissions:

**2018/2481/P to dig out the basement at the front with a lightwell and stairway access.** This doesn't look right either. He can't take most of the garden for this. It looks bad compared to all the rest who have made basements which are ok because they're small and tidy with plants or gravel. Only a few have stairs which ruin the front. Where is the space for more bins which are now bigger?

**2018/2514/P to create a roof terrace on the existing flat roof at 3<sup>rd</sup> floor level.** Camden should have some control or rules for these because they make neighbours lives a nightmare. You take account of the 'overlooking' (invading our privacy with glass barriers only 5foot 6) but the noise and light disturbance is worse. All the residents at the back will be overhearing the sounds and seeing the lights at the top of this house and when we're disturbed I know from experience that the Noise Control team won't help us.

Please refuse these applications and protect us from such a bad design and nuisance.
