1 The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

2 All new external work shall be carried out in materials that resemble, as closely as possible, in colour and texture those of the existing building, unless otherwise

specified in the approved application.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy D1 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the following approved plans; EX-(00, 01, 02, 02); PD-(01, 02, 03); Planning Statement.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interest of proper planning.

Informative(s):

1 Reasons for granting permission.

The proposed rooflights are considered to represent minor alterations that are acceptable design and material terms. They would be of modest design and size, and would be fitted flush within the roof slopes, ensuring no harm is caused to the character of the host building or surrounding area

Given the location of the rooflights at main roof level, no harm would be caused to the amenity of neighbouring properties in terms of loss of light, outlook or privacy.

No comments have been received prior to the determination of this application. The site's planning history was taken into account when coming to this decision. The application site is not listed, nor is it located in a conservation area.

As such, the proposal is in general accordance with policy D1 of the Camden Local Plan 2017 and accords with the London Plan 2016 and National Planning Policy Framework 2012.
