We understood, and accepted, the Royal College's need to acknowledge benefactors, and, on the basis that the installation is reversible, had no objection. Fixings should not permanently alter the wall to which the installation is attached.</p> <p>We would have been happy to engage in pre-application discussion, and would still be prepared to discuss the application informally.</p>
