Proposal: Replacement of single glazed doors and windows on front/side/rear elevations to No.5 and 6 with aluminium double glazing.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason:

Reason for Refusal

The proposed development, by virtue of the loss of characteristic detailing, inappropriate design and loss of uniformity to the terrace, would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the host building, terrace and the Hampstead Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and Policy D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan 2017 and policies DH1 and DH2 of the Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan (2018).



In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
