The submitted details outlining community safety measures are considered acceptable and would adequately protect the amenities of residents living in the area.

The Canal and River Trust have been consulted who have confirmed that the proposed benches between buttresses look robust and should not cause obstruction. They had no other specific responses to the remaining elements. The Council's Trees and Landscaping Officer has also confirmed that the details are considered sufficient to demonstrate that the bench seating along the towpath, antigraffiti brickwork on towpath walls, planting, towpath wall buttresses to prevent hiding, and anti-climb security gates that will be closed at night are suitable for the site and fit for purpose.

As such, the detail are in accordance with Policy DP26 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies and condition 40 (parts C, D, E, F, G) can be discharged.
