Dear Sirs,

The Cedar tree in my neighbour's (29 Grove Place) small front corner garden is causing both myself and my neighbour (Matthew Sowerby) concern. The tree stands within 2.8m of the frontage of 29 Grove Place and within 2.0m of the Party Fence.

We wish to have the tree removed completely for the following reasons:

- Currently the tree spreads over the party fence, roof and terrace. The crown is grossly overgrown, it dramatically reduces daylight to one bedroom and the kitchen.
- The spread of the tree over the roof and terrace leaves a litter of needles and encourages the growth of moss in damp conditions, which will lead to deterioration of the tiles and blockage of the drains.
- The tree is growing exceedingly fast and it has already been pruned three times this century (last time 2015) and it is now overgrown again.
- The tree has far outgrown the small garden and completely dominates both adjacent buildings. It has become unsuitable for it's location.

We hope that you can sympathise with our problem.
