It also causes harm to the setting of the Grade I-listed St. Giles-in-the-Fields Church, which sits directly opposite the applicant's building. Local Plan policy D2 (k) specifies that the council will "resist development that would cause harm to significance of a listed building through an effect on its setting." Further, the applicant acknowledges the historic value of this building and to change its symmetry would be not enhance the building (see D&A Statement). The consented scheme is preferred. The CGCA also is concerned by the demolishing/removal of render and the damage this may cause to the building. |
