Application submitted under Section 96a of the Town and Country Planning Act (1990) (As Amended)

On behalf of our clients, Anglo American and De Beers (AA & DB), please find enclosed an application submitted under Section 96a of the Town and Country Planning Act (1990) (As Amended) seeking Non-Material Amendments to planning permission 2017/4586/P relating to the above site.

The proposed amendments relate to the addition of ventilation louvres above the window openings along the Saffron Hill façade; and the addition of window vents along the façade facing the staircase linking Saffron Hill to Charterhouse Street. With regards to the latter amendment, new vents are proposed, but in the shape and location of the existing window openings used for ventilation. It is considered that the amendments will not materially alter the appearance of the Saffron Hill façade and are de minimis so can be considered under Section 96a of the Act.
