

- Factory finished with high quality preservative, primer and two coats of micro-porous paint

The traditional box sash window has been a part of British architecture since the seventeenth century. Amazingly, the design remains almost unchanged. Traditional sash windows operate using a mechanism that consists of cords and pulleys counterbalanced with weights.

Quadruple draught strips prevent rattles. High insulation glazing units drastically reduce heat loss and down-draughts. Multi-layered timber and careful attention to detail help minimise swelling and warping that causes jamming on windows of lesser quality during wet weather. For narrower frame profiles, spring balanced sliding sash windows are also available.
