The proposed roof balustrade and privacy screening, by reason of its scale, siting and proposed materials, would appear as an incongruous alien structure which harms the architectural integrity of the host building and results in excessive perceptions of bulk. The proposal would also result in harm to the character and appearance of the Redington / Frognal Conservation Area. The scheme would



therefore be contrary to policies D1 and D2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
