- 1. It is our client's intention to create a sublet jeweller store with its own street access with a fire rated wall providing the separation. Each will have their own staff and retained toilet facilities.
- 2. Part of the proposal includes removal of one of the frontages and canopy sited on the Greville Street elevation with the installation of a powder coated aluminium shopfront with lobby entrance. The new tiled lobby will have 2no risers and landing area as detailed to make up the pavement and retail area floor levels
- 3. The new sub-let interior will be left as a blank canvas for a future tenant to fit out as necessary.
- 4. Design considerations are to be sympathetic with the area using materials to complement the retained Carlo Jewellery frontages as detailed.

Design Overview

- A. No extensions are proposed.
- B. New shopfront to create the sub-let area will be in powder coated aluminium having an armour plate entrance door set within a new stepped lobby entrance area.
- C. The main fascia's will be retained with the lettering over the sub-let removed to receive lettering by a future tenant.
- D. Existing pilasters, tiled stall riser upstands, fascia's and cornices retained
- E. New Lobby entrance reveal to be rendered to match existing finishes
