A similar sky light was approved in an extension in the shop at 50 Neal Street many years ago (which sits underneath the second bedroom in my flat) and I have constant issues with the light levels and more importantly with noise issues surrounding it, because of the loud music played in the shop, which is open till 2100/2200 at night.</p> <p>The proposed extension will also block up the windows and therefore block out the light of the storage rooms provided for the flats above [REDACTED]. Surely this won't be permitted?</p> <p>Additionally allowing the shop to expand its footprint, will only increase the noise capacity of the shop overall, and noise from the shops on Neal street is currently a very aggravating and significant issue that needs addressing.</p> <p>Neal Street has for many years been a residential street with shops, but more lately the increasing number of shops and shoppers, longer opening hours, louder shop music and shop workers selling outside their shops, has severely encroached on life for residents.</p> <p>The proposal concerns me greatly [REDACTED].
