As you know Harrington Street is a small quiet residential road. I am very concerned about the safety of Coniston and the other blocks, Harrington Street will not be able to bear the heavy weight of the lorries, there will be constant vibration from these vehicles and therefore they will cause structural damage to Coniston and the other blocks. Steve Christofy from the Traffic Working Group for Regents park Estate maintains that there is no need for the lorries route to come through Harrington Street. He said that the route could use Granby Terrace or to put a temporary access straight from Hampstead Road onto Silverdale, as it was promised by HS2 at the HOUSE OF LORDS Also and, most important, there has not been a democratic consultation with the residents of Harrington Street, nobody has been notified in writing that the lorries route would have come through Harrington Street. A part from unbearable noise and vibrations there will be a huge amount of pollution in an area which is highly polluted. Coniston is sandwiched between Harrington Street and Hampstead Road with its heavy traffic. Therefore we will be hit by heavy pollution from both Harrington Street and Hampstead Road. As I have already mentioned before, I am ill with depression and anxiety, so I tend to stay at home most of the time. I have had cancer and it is paramount that I do not have to live with the lethal danger of heavy pollution. Quite a few of Coniston residents are elderly. I personally know of other residents who have suffered from cancer. Now their health is put at risk by HS2's proposed lorries route.</p> <p>Also children's health will be put at risk. So I am in protest about the proposed route and I do expect LBC to reject HS2 application to use this route. LBC has the duty of care to protect hi residents and his properties. So why has this now been going changed? Steve Christofi from the 'Traffic Working Group for Regents Park Estate' also said the same that Harrington Street would never be used for a lorry run.</p> <p>HS2 are proposing to paint double yellow lines on the road, stopping all the residents parking outside their homes for well over a year. Residents pay in advance to park for their cars to park near homes. PRKing has already been disrupted by HS2. And now they will remove at least another 50 parking spaces. This is ridiculous.</p> <p>As a resident I would like to know why I had not been notified of the HS2 lorry route. I only found out from another neighbour. I have asked many other residents in oniston and not one single person has received any letter regarding this matter. This is just of good enough.</p> <p>I am also very concerned about the pollution all these Lorry will cause. Coniston flats are sandwiched between Harrington Street and Hampstead Road. As you know this is already very high polluted area. I have health issues as it is and the even higher pollution will only make things worse, there are many old and young people living along Harrington Street. If this lorry route goes ahead, I fear got there health too.</p> <p>I am therefore protesting against HS2 to use Harrington Street for their lorry route. I hope Camden Council takes my protest seriously.
