I object to Planning Application 2018/2859/P (site: 6 Streatley Place NW3 1HP) on the following grounds:

1. Intensification of use/over-development: the proposal is now for “four new self-contained flats across four floors” and envisages the “excavation of lower ground level to introduce a new basement...” (page 3 of the Design & Access Statement). It also seeks “an increase in volume to the previous approved scheme” (page 7 of the Design & Access Statement).
2. The draft Construction Management Plan does not, in my view, adequately address the very real constraints of accessing, excavating or building on the site and accommodating an off-site compound over a 72 to 104 week period (approx). In any event, the Construction Management Plan should be considered in combination with other developments which are proceeding in this constrained location.
