LIST OF CHANGES BETWEEN CURRENT PROPOSAL AND APPROVED DRAWINGS

The following changes have been made following design development:

1 External material to all elevations changed from timber shingles to brick to match the Queen Elizabeth II Centre (currently under construction). This change was made so that the East Wing relates more closely to the Queen Elizabeth II Centre and is more in keeping with the rest of the brick buildings on the campus.

The intention is that the East Wing will be read as a 'gateway' to the campus when viewed from the main entrance pathway leading to the Queen Elizabeth II Centre.

- Windows and doorways to all elevations have been adjusted in location, scale and proportion. The windows are mainly sliding windows to relate more closely to the Queen Elizabeth II Centre and will be of the same colour and material.
- 3 The height to the top of coping has changed slightly from 28.580 previously to 28.442 currently shown (Note: this may change slightly +/- 50mm depending on the 'as built' detail and tolerances on site.
