Installation of parasol and timber decking at rear of premises (retrospective).

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- The timber decking, by reason of its design, extent, footprint, materials and relationship with the listed building, is considered to be harmful to the historic interest of the listed building and the character and appearance of this part of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 and D2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
- The proposed parasol, by reason of its design, size, siting, material and insubordinate relationship with the host building, is considered to be harmful to the historic interest of the listed building, the open nature of its rear garden, and the character and appearance of this part of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area,



contrary to policies D1, D2 and A2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2018.

ENFORCEMENT ACTION TO BE TAKEN

The Council has authorised the Planning Department to instruct the Borough Solicitor to issue an Enforcement Notice alleging breach of planning control.
