				The availability of a local launderette in a community is a vital element of infrastructure and an essential community facility.	
				The Belsize area includes many single rooms and studio flats without laundry facilities and with occupants from a diverse mix of age, gender and ethnic background.	
				It is the only launderette in Belsize Park and one of only two in an area bounded by Swiss Cottage, Hampstead and Chalk Farm. Both of these launderettes are in the same ownership, with the other, in Englands Lane, also under risk of closure.	
				It is included in the Belsize Village Neighbourhood Centre, the definition of which specifically includes	
				Launderettes (Camden Local Plan 2017, 2.60) and it is Camden Council policy under this plan to "ensure that	
				any development in them (Neighbourhood Centres), does not harm the function, character or success of that centre" (CLP 9.23).
