PROPOSED SCHEME



The proposed extension will increase the hotel capacity from the current 114 hotel rooms to 132 hotel rooms while improving the extant hotel standard of accommodation.

The current proposal will include:

- Side Extension
- Rear Extension
- Roof Extension

These extensions have been designed to create the smallest impact on the existing building appearance and Bloomsbury conservation area.

Side Extension

The slender side extension to the north-east side will replace the existing external stair while replicating the window formats and materials of the existing building.

Rear Extension

The rear extension will add one extra floor to the existing north-east rear wing while enlarging to the rear some of the back rooms.

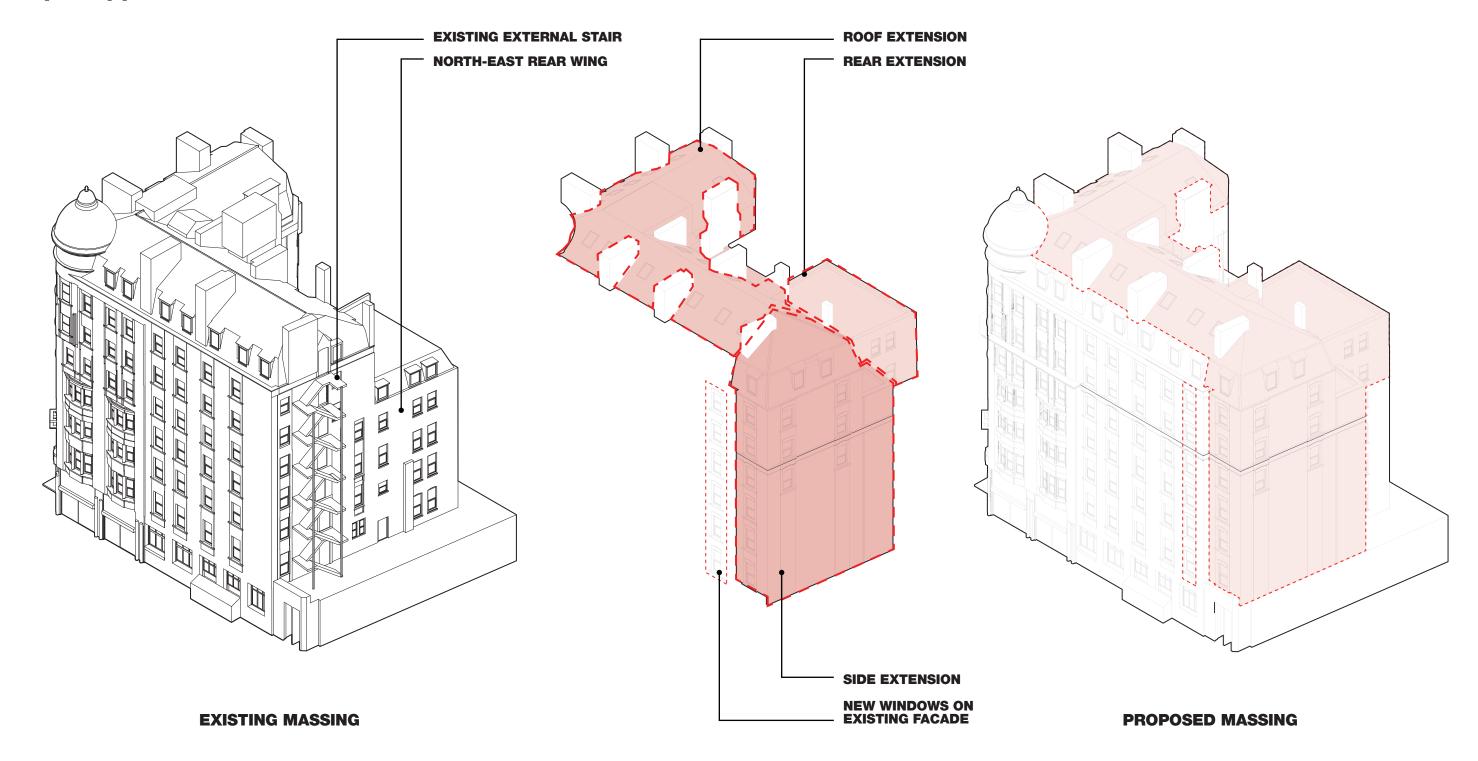
