I note from the sparsely detailed drawings, these concerns;

1. Approximately half of the extension roof is noted as finished with paving which indicates a roof terrace. If so, users would be closely looking down into our glazed conservatory which being the dining area is very much part of [REDACTED] living space. Unacceptable.
2. The outline of the proposed extension extends horizontally beyond our party wall and higher than the party wall of no.18.

I am confused by the procedures. A notice was posted in the street 4? Weeks ago saying comments period finishes on August 1. Online I found written documents but no drawings. Early this week, after 2 calls to planning I was eventually given the drawing ref. No.

I presume that the drawings have only been available within the last day or so, and are so vague that our understanding of the proposal is extremely limited.

I hope that after publication of detailed drawings we will have a proper consultation period.
