A cherry tree in my back garden (A on plan) is infected by some kind of blight. I have removed the worst affected leaves but the infection appears to be still spreading (see photo 003_Blight). The tree is a very unattractive shape as the branches on one side are bare and appear to have died. The better branches overhang the garden next door at No. 29 where building works are going on, and I anticipate they will have to be trimmed or removed in the course of work on next door's extension. I would therefore like to remove the tree and replace it with a tree of smaller size, species to be selected once it becomes clear what new planting the neighbours intend to carry out.

While tree works are going on, I would also like approval to reduce the height and reshape the crown of two other trees, a silver birch (B on plan, photo 004_silver birch.jpg) and a cherry (C on plan, photo 005_pink cherry.jpg): both of these have grown well beyond their original size, are now quite unattractive and are causing unacceptable shading of neighbours' gardens (and consequent complaints).
