The applicant does not mention that the listing description includes: Probably by James Burton.</p> <p>The Bloomsbury CAAC objects strongly to this application: it involves the complete removal of the original exterior wall at lower rear, obliterates the original access to the garden, and completely removes an internal structural wall. The proposed wholly-glazed extension is thoroughly out of character with the rest of the building.</p> <p>An application for listed building consent should show the neighbouring buildings, and the fact that it does not in this case leads us to suspect that the other houses in the terrace are also well-preserved, an additional reason for rejecting this application.</p> <p>The claim that the garden would be 'enlarged' is daft.</p>
