I object to the recently applied thick render to the original brickwork of the extensive side and back of this Camden conservation area building. This cladding has dramatically changed the appearance of this traditional building in the historically important York Way. On the "Proposed elevations" it is stated "RENDER TO MATCH BRICKWORK COLOUR TO BE AGREED WITH LA" I completely object to render being there at all applied to this historic building whatever colour. The original old brickwork underneath it is beautiful in colour and material and has been covered over and the cladding needs to be completely removed from it. I agree with the proposed removal of unauthorised windows to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd floor side elevation. I object to any kind of windows being added to the original old wall. These windows are completely inappropriate to the side of this conservation area building. The "Existing elevations" shown on Camden website show 3 windows described as "ex timber casement" however those windows were completely newly installed very recently as can be clearly seen on Google street view. There were not timber or any kind of window where they were. I object to the installation of railings around the second floor rear elevation as again this is not appropriate to this historic old building. I agree to the removal of unauthorised 2nd floor rear canopy. I object to the canopies added as they do not look appropriate for this historic building. Having a balcony with railings also would lead to loss of privacy of neighbouring properties as it would overlook. There is and has already been a major problem with noise for residents at the back, from this same building from the floor below. The application site notice has now been missing for over 8 days.
