REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

(TPO REF. S9 - T4) FRONT GARDEN - 1 x London Plane - Fell to ground level

The Council has considered your application dated 19 June 2018 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The application tree (T1), a large mature London plane tree is highly visible from the public realm, provides a high level of visual amenity to the public and significantly contributes to the character of this part of the conservation area. T1 is in excess of 20m in height, appears to be in at least fair condition both physiologically and structurally, and to have a significant safe useful life expectancy. The documents submitted with the application allege that the tree is contributing to structural damage at the same property.



The movement the level monitoring data shows is erratic and is not considered to show seasonal movement that would demonstrate the movement is vegetation related.

The movement appears to be greatest toward the rear of the property, which is the furthest point from T1 that was monitored. No details of trial pits at the rear of the property were submitted.

The pruning that has been carried out since the damage was discovered is not considered to have been regular or extensive enough to demonstrate that cyclical pruning is not a viable method of controlling the movement.

The application has be refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and the character of the conservation area.
