### **NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA**

Proposed Work:

REAR/MIDDLE GARDEN: 1x Magnolia - Trim back rose to clear building by 1.00m. Trim back rose to control encroachment into the adjacent birch tree. Reduce lateral and sub lateral growth by up to 20%.

2 x Birch - Thin crown density by 20% and tip prune branches growing towards house by 15%

Magnolia Group: Lightly reduce lateral and sub lateral growth which overhangs the lawn by approximately 15%

1x Griselinia Shrub - Trim back to previous reduction points

1x Large Bay - Reduce to as tight and compact shape aprox 15-20%.

1x Small bay - Reduce back to previous reduction points

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 18 July 2018 and does not wish to object.


