				Applications, alterations and amendments concerning this property have continued since the first application in 2014 and these latest plans will allow a serious intrusion upon the privacy of the neighbbouring property in Compayne Gardens which would now be overlooked by the high level windows which will be installed on the south elevation of the building if this application is permitted.  CRASH would suggest that the additional features contained in this application were not included in the original application, granted in 2016, because the applicant knew that it was unlikely that permission would be granted for such out of character features at that time and that the application would be refused, Permitting applicants to continually vary the conditions of a permission already granted, as this developer is with this application, will allow the alteration of the features and character of, not just this particular building, but of the whole of the South Hampstead Conservation Area. This application is typical of the sort of underhand methods used by some developers to obtain alterations, additions and amendments which Camden Council would normally accept runs counter to its own policy for buildings in a conservation area and so refuse  Camden must accept that to continually allow developers to use such methods of varying an original application is contributing -drip by drip - to the denigration of its own conservation area policy and must be stopped  CRASH respectfully asks you to refuse this application.
