Proposal: Variation of condition 17 (approved plans) of planning permission 2017/4586/P dated 24/01/2018 (as amended 31/07/2018, ref 2018/3551/P) for extensions and refurbishment of the existing part seven, part five storey (plus basement) building including erection of a single storey roof extension to Saffron Hill block, part two-storey and part five-storey extensions within central courtyard, part removal of the existing façade and part replacement with new glazed, metal and stonework façade to Charterhouse Street. Access alterations including redesign of existing pedestrian entrance and relocation of vehicular entrance on Charterhouse Street. remodelling and replacement of existing plant and equipment.
