I have just received notification of intended works to tree(s) in a Conservation Area with the above reference. This particular case concerns felling a Deodar Cedar tree in the rear garden of No. 36 Elsworthy Road.

I believed a few years ago, No. 34 Elsworthy Road had also applied to fell a number of trees around her artist studio in her rear garden, including the Cedar tree in No. 36 Elsworthy Road. A Tree Preservation Order (TPO) was subsequently issued due to objections raised by the neighbours because these are mature trees in a conservation area and felling them would impact the environment and reduce privacy of the neighbourhood.

Please confirm that this TPO is still in place and applies to the cedar tree in No. 36 Elsworthy Road. If not, [REDACTED] of No. 36 Elsworthy Road, I would like object to the proposed work for reasons outlined above.
