DD REAR GARDEN: 1x Pear tree, fell

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 05 July 2018 and does not wish to object.

Informative(s):

Where the removal of dead/dangerous tree(s) has taken place the owner has a duty under Section 213 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) to plant a replacement. In this case the Council requires that a pear tree (Pyrus communis) be planted as a heavy standard with a girth size of 12-14cms. The ground should be prepared to the standards set out in BS5236:1975. The tree should be suitably staked and tied. The replacement should be planted by the end of March 2019.
