I did make a postal application trying to oppose the first application for planning permission for Flat A but I didn't receive a response and the planning was granted. I am writing again opposing the second and current application for planning permission for Flat A both by email and also by post to be sure, as far as I can, that you receive it.

After a visit on Thursday, 16th August to the owner of Flat A, Pat Traynor's flat, at her invitation, to see exactly what she proposes to do with her extension, I was completely shocked to learn of the full extent of the proposed extension.
