## DECISION

Town and Country Planning Acts 1990 (as amended)

### **NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA**

Proposed Work:

IN GROUNDS ADJACENT: 1 x Holm Oak (*Quercus ilex*) (T1) Suggested works: Prune back (Evergreen) x 1 overhanging branches by 2 - 2.5m

1 x Magnolia (T2) - Lift over Camelia by 0.5m and lightly prune remaining crown by 0.5 - 0.75m to give a more rounded outline

1 x Thuja (Hedge) (T3) - Reduce the height at the bottom of the slope by approx. 2.5m (As directed by client) maintaining a straight level throughout the hedge. Hard trim both faces but ensure not to trim beyond the green foliage.

1 x Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*) (T4) - Give 1.5m clearance from the hedge and reduce remainder of the crown by up to 1.5m Left of Horse Chestnut

1 x Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*) - Reduce height by 2m and reduce sides by up to 1m to blend. Right hand side of above location

1 x Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*) - Reduce height by 3m and prune side growth to blend lift canopy by 1m. Rear of Horse Chestnut

1 x Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*) - Reduce overlong spires back into the main body of the crown making sure there is a substantial gap of light between the top of the crown and the Horse Chestnut




The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 26 July 2018 and does not wish to object.
