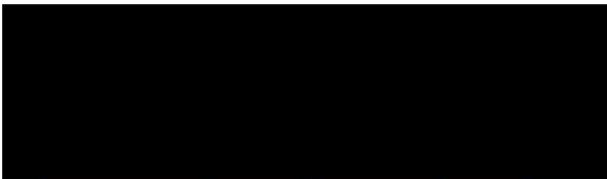

I act for local residents who overlook this site. It is understood that a planning application has been lodged but not yet registered.

It is believed that the developer and his team have met with Planning Officers and there is concern over what has been said. In a separate email I have made a Freedom of Information Request to deal with this.

It is understood that the Council allows Planning Officers to under external work. If this is indeed the case then there is concern that Officers who have dealt with pre-application advice will have met the developer on previous occasions and cannot, therefore, offer wholly independent advice on the current application.

In these circumstances it would be appreciated if the Case Officer allocated to this application would have had no contact with the developer in the past or

elsewhere. You will appreciate concern over this matter. We wish to ensure that the procedure is entirely transparent and free from any apparent bias, real or perceived.
