



1 Grey circles indicate the full canopycast of existing trees. Rear of garden to be planted with woodland shrubs and bulbs and floor to be covered with a good qualilty weed membrane and bark. This area to be kept fairly wild to encourage wildlife with log edging to areas of informal planting

Areas under the trees to be planted with Hellebores (December) Snowdrops (February) Daffodils (March) Bluebells (April) These will flower before the tree canopy is fully open. They will be intersperse with various evergreen ferns.Summer interest will be provided by Euphorbia amygdaloides var robbiae and common Foxgloves planted towards the edges as they need dappled shade to thrive. Winter colour will be provided by the abundant red orange berries from the rear hedge of Pyracantha 'firethorn'.


- 2 New border under existing beech hedging to be interspersed with Pyracantha 'firethorn'this border should also be planted with some sturdy (football proof!) evergreen shrubs like Elaeagnus, Osmanthus of Viburnham to screen the fence. Summer interest can be provided by planting shade loving Hydrangeas and Japanese Anenomes
- Rear border behind garden studio to be planted with a hedge of Pyracantha 'firethorn'.


 Plant tallest specimens so that rear window is sheilded from neighbours
- 4 Focal point and stump raised beds These areas have a sunny aspect and can be planted with a full colour palate and scented climbers to be enjoyed in summertime.

- 5 Paving to raised patio Completo Argentario Paving to pathway still be selected but reccomend use of an ethically sourced Indian Sandstone to blend in gently with soft muted shades of garden and be in keeping with the redbrick 'Hampstead' environment. Excelent selection of paving available from CG Edwards Ltd.
- 6 Lighting still to be specified but is indicated on sides of steps for safety


