Dear Gideon

I am writing to raise my severe concerns about the proposed heavy lorry route on Harrington Square NW1 for the HS2 works. I own a flat at [REDACTED] and lived there for many years until recently, so I understand the road and its residents rather well.

There are a lot of young families and elderly residents in Hurdwick House. Because many of them make daily use of Harrington Square Gardens, young and old people are very often crossing this road slowly or without paying much attention to traffic. The road is frequently bottlenecked with traffic caused by delivery lorries and buses stopping, and cars stopping to park in the parking bays on the park side of the road. All of the office workers at Greater London House come to the park to eat their lunch on nice days, in a relative oasis in such a central spot. Many of the houses on Harrington Sq are HMO's and people work or even sleep during the daytimes only a matter of feet away from the road. I fear that the proposal to direct 20-35 lorries down this stretch of road for 16 months would negatively impact a great number of lives and a better alternative must be available.

I am grateful for your consideration of this matter, and know that many of my neighbours are as concerned as I am. Please do not allow HS2 to destroy our little community.
