The Council's conservation officer has reviewed the details submitted and is satisfied that the proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the special architectural and historic interest of the listed building.

The handrail and balustrades to the stairs are traditional and appropriate for the setting. Whilst the railings to the Pond Square elevation do not have finials and may appear relatively modern, there is a variety of boundary treatments including similar railings on the same side of the square and so the proposed style would not look out of place. The proposed railings would be an improvement on the existing situation.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policy D2 of the Camden Local Plan 2017. The proposed development also accords with the London Plan 2016 and the National Planning Policy Framework.
