APPLICATION FOR PLANNING PERMISSION – 200 GRAYS INN ROAD, LONDON WC1X 8XZ

This application for planning permission has been prepared on behalf of Great Ropemaker Property Limited for minor alterations and additions to the existing mechanical plant at 200 Grays Inn Road.

Planning Application

This application (PP-07254231) seeks approval for the following:

 Partial removal of existing redundant plant and replacement with new condensers and extract ductwork within the external lightwell at the ground floor.

Policy Context

Policy A4 of the *Camden Local Plan 2017* and Section 6 of the Amenity *Camden Planning Guidance* (Amenity CPG) sets out requirements for the preparation of an acoustic report to accompany planning applications relating to plant, ventilation, air extraction and conditioning equipment. The Amenity CPG and Appendix 3 of the Local Plan also outline noise and vibration thresholds and the need to mitigate any acoustic impacts as part of the design process.

In accordance with these policies, an assessment has been carried out by a qualified acoustic consultant. The findings of this assessment are summarised in the following section.



Planning Assessment

As part of this application for partial removal of existing redundant plant and replacement with new condensers and extract ductwork, an assessment of the proposed plant has been carried out. This assessment found that the proposed plant is expected to comply with the relevant noise limits contained within the Camden's planning policies.
