I Lesley Mary Strawbridge of 4a Lindfield Gardens DO SOLEMNLY and SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:


- 1. I have owned the freehold house at 4a Lindfied Gardens and lived there with my family since April 2000

- 4. Number 4 Lindfield Gardens has been let to tenants and I attach excerpts from inventory reports prepared at the outset of tenancies commencing in August 2008, October 2011 and August 2014. The excerpts are photographs of the garden, some of which are date stamped, and they show the fence in position at the dates concerned (Attachment 3).


Since July 2008, the land shaded green on the attached plan has been used as follows:


- 1. It was used as a vegetable garden until about 2012 and I attach a letter from our neighbour at that time which confirms this (Attachment 4).


From the upstairs bedroom window of my house I could see the heads of adults including you, Dom, your gardener / handyman and your nanny moving about behind the fence from time to time.


