The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- The proposed rear extension and balcony are considered unacceptable by reason of their size and massing, causing harm to the character, proportions and architectural detail of the host building and wider Elsworthy Conservation Area, and as such would be contrary to policies D1 and D2 of the Camden Local Plan.
- 2 The proposed balcony, by reason of its size and height in relation to neighbouring

buildings, would cause unacceptable noise disturbance and loss of privacy to neighbouring residents, and as such would be contrary to policy A1 of the Camden Local Plan.
