In my view the use of the proposed finish on the areas where the existing rendering is to be removed would give the building an un warranted prominence to the detriment of the Conservation Area and the setting of the adjoining listed house.

At the Planning Cttee the Applicants showed a cgi ,this misleadingly ,showed an even appearance over the whole facade.

In reality this cannot be achieved there would ,self evidently ,be a material difference in appearance between the areas where the rendering has been removed as per sample and the areas of the facade where the existing fairface brickwork has been painted.

The result would give the building a" piebald" appearance.

The Applicants should be asked to prepare adjoining sample panels showing the proposed finishes to both the areas (rendering removed/fairface brickwork) so that's more accurate assessment of the proposed finished appearance of the building can be made.
