OBJECTION TO PLANNING APPLICATION

I live in the [REDACTED] the gardens of both 62 and 64 Menelik Road.

Whilst I have no objection to a reasonable sized workshop or shed – such as has been erected in the garden of number 62 - the proposed size of the outbuilding now under scrutiny for number 64 is out of all proportion to the size of the garden and would seriously impair the view from the rear of my flat. From the plans submitted it would seem to take over the majority of the garden, and with the inclusion of all services could in effect become a potential extra living unit: a self-contained flat in all but name. Also, because of the position of existing mature trees, it cannot be “tucked away” at the back or in the corner of the garden, but would be four-square in the middle of the available space, totalling dominating the garden and the view.

I would be grateful if you could confirm receipt of this objection.
