Dear Mr. Little, Mr. Bell and Mr. Bakall, I am writing on behalf of Barbara Dohmann and myself in regard to the proposed felling of two Leylandii and one Mock Orange tree just over the border between [REDACTED] 45 Netherhall Gardens, [REDACTED]. These trees form an essential screen and amenity, as well as habitat for birds, in our conservation area and were in fact mandated to be planted there by the council some three decades ago, following the illegal felling of 27 trees by a developer on that property. Barbara Dohmann, who appeared at a public inquiry about said development at the time, has exact details of the events and can provide them if necessary. Our request is that you should suspend permission for any felling of this kind with immediate effect.
