Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Bay (T1) : Fell to ground level and treat stump to prevent any further growth.

1 x Silver Birch (T2) - Reduce height by approximately 2m, reduce lateral growth by approximately 1.5m, raise crown over the road to approximately 4m - clean out crown

1 x Holly (T3) - Remove the stem on the left hand side and trim remaining stem to achieve a neat rounded outline.

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Ginkgo/Maidenhair (T5) - Reduce height to approximately down to half Tree x 1 way of the bedroom window and reduce lateral growth by approximately 0.75m to try to achieve a column shape.

1 x Silver Birch (T4) - Crown reduce back to previous points, remove branch growing towards clients windows and clean out crown.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 13 September 2018 and does not wish to object.
