I have lived for 31 years in [REDACTED] which is next to 5 Honeybourne Road. All the objections which I made to the previous planning application remain valid and I wish these to be renewed.

I am particularly concerned about the damage which the demolition of the 5 Honeybourne Road garages and the construction of the new house, especially pile driving, will cause to Block 1 of Harvard Court whose internal foundations (over 110 years old) are not to modern standards.

There will also be damage to the wall between Harvard Court and 5 Honeybourne Road and possibly also to the wall between Harvard Court and the garages at the rear of West End Lane.
