Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed change of use to a museum, by reason of the unjustified loss of residential floorspace, would be detrimental to the amount of permanent residential floorspace provided in the borough, contrary to Policy H1 (Maximising housing supply) and Policy H3 (Protecting existing homes) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017; and Policy 3.14 (Existing Housing) of the London Plan March 2016.
