Hi my name is Pauline Purdue aged 49. I live in north west London. My life changed when I was diagnosed with Breast Cancer in 2011 aged 42. I have had treatment in a number of different hospitals around London.

Whilst attending these hospitals I have met many people who have been supported by Breast Cancer Haven in Fulham, for therapies, workshops, financial support, counselling, and a place to talk with others of which who can share their experiences. I have not been able to do this and feel I have missed out on a lot of support as the fulham location is very difficult to get to from where I live. I was asked to attend the Fulham location for a therapy session. The journey took me an hour and a half to get there, I had to change lines a number of times and trains being so busy, by the time I got there I was exhausted and quite anxious and unable to enjoy my experience. I was also thinking I have to do this journey going home. Hence my reason for not returning.

I fully support the relocation for Future Dreams House to Kings Cross as this is a central location, easy to access, no more awkward journeys, and long distance travelling as this would cut my traveling time to half an hour. I will also be able to make full use of all the facilities that Future Dreams can offer. This especially enables me to bring along family members to an environment, that is very spacious has lots of rooms and also to be able to use all the services that they provide. With more people being affected with Breast Cancer this will enable people the opportunity to travel to this great central location from all parts of the UK using the accessible transport links.

I would urge you to seriously consider the above and support this application as this would and could mean the world to Breast Cancer survivors/ carers.
