My name is Thora Frost and I have lived in the [REDACTED] since 2010 first at [REDACTED] and then at [REDACTED]. I wish to oppose the appeal by Polar Bren Ltd and Jita Lukka against an enforcement notice EN171284 dated 20.12.17 issued by Camden in relation to the South Fairground Site.

From, [REDACTED] (and previously when we lived in [REDACTED]) we were unable to see anything past the trees and the fence before the development at the site started. Now we look directly at a building which resembles a chalet. We can clearly see the lights inside the building in the evening and people coming and going. Obviously the building did not appear overnight, and we were very aware of building works ongoing from around April 2017 for about 12 months. It was very noisy and distributive, especially as work often continued on Sundays and bank holidays. Astonishing lack of consideration towards neighbours and complete disregard towards any planning process. In addition a great deal of foliage including trees have been cut down.
