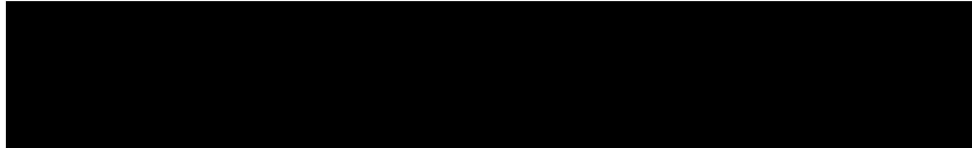
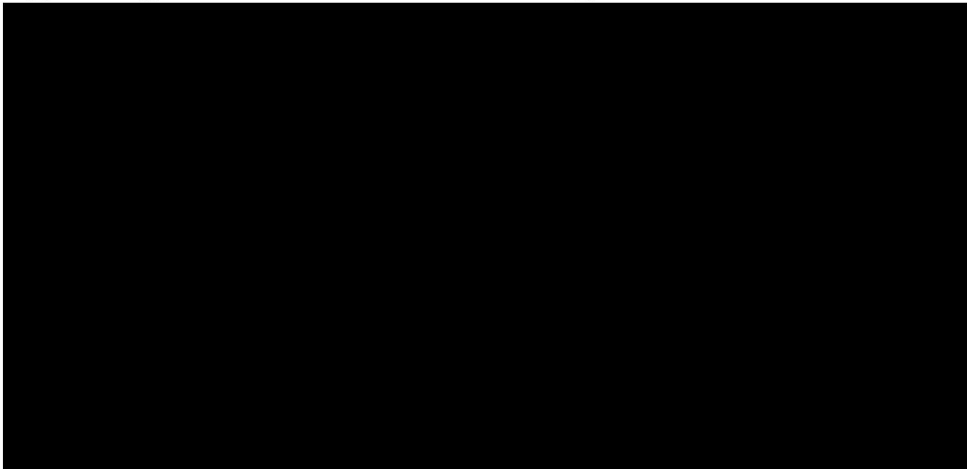

These trees should be treated as a coherent whole. All of them feature on Camden's TPO list and all of them, or their equivalents, feature on the 1869 Ordnance Survey map. They are highly significant trees.

They desperately need some TLC but just reducing them, and reducing them by different amounts, is not the best solution. These are all street trees and have a huge impact on the visual amenity of the area. The tree officer should visit the sites with a view to meeting their arboriculturalist and working out a strategic plan for these trees which, truth to tell, look rather unkempt. Alternatively, the tree officer should invite them to work together with their arboriculturalist to devise a more coherent long term plan.
