Following on from our conversation last Friday regarding the Gloucester Gate playground in Regents Park, please see the attached and below for your consideration:

- I have discussed the points you raised with James Virgo, (my LUC colleague who issued the planning drawings), and he has confirmed the following:
 - o Drg 310: the colour coding on this plan is intended for soil depths for proposed planting only – and is to be considered a ground level finish, unless otherwise specified in the design (i.e. for new earth mounds – such as shown in the attached DAS page 65)
